## Math Pre-Assessment

- Testing on 5/18 or 5/20 from 6PM – 6:45PM
- Used by the Math Department to help place students in the appropriate freshman math class
- Also used to place some students in the Math Support class for extra academic interventions and support. (Students may not self-select out of this class.)

## English Pre-Assessment

- Essay submission by 5/21
- Used by the Humanities Department to give the teachers an idea of the writing skills students have
- Also used to place some students in the English Support class for extra academic interventions and support. (Students may not self-select out of this class.)

# Math Pre-Assessment on 5/18 or 5/20

The pre-assessment exam is designed to help the Math Department place students in the appropriate freshman Math class.

- ❑ The Math Pre-assessment Exam will be given on Tuesday, May 18 or Thursday, May 20 from 6PM to 6:45PM.
- ❑ Students have two options to choose from: in-person at EMHS or proctored remotely through Zoom.

- ❑ Please do not wait until the last minute to register for the math test.
- ❑ Students will solve all math problems without a calculator, phone, online resources or another person's help.

# English Pre-Assessment – DUE by 4PM on 5/21/21

The pre-assessment activity is designed to determine how the EMHS Humanities teachers can best help students succeed in freshman English.

- Students will be asked to:
  1. Read an article with pro and con statements
  2. Formulate an opinion
  3. Then write a thesis statement and supporting paragraph
- Students will access the pre-assessment on the new student webpage and submit their writing assignment directly on the webpage. It must be submitted by 4PM on Friday, May 21.

7. Submit the writing assignment directly on the webpage. (There is not a save feature, so you must complete the writing assignment in one sitting.)
