Use of Federal Funds

Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, public schools have been allocated federal funds through various relief packages.

Most of the federal funds flow through the Albuquerque Public Schools district, which then allocates portions thereof to charter schools like East Mountain High School.

EMHS has received CARES and ESSR funds and expects to receive funds through the recently approved ARPA (American Rescue Plan).

EMHS, through collaboration with key stakeholders, will utilize these funds for the following projects:

- Technology (hardware and software) acquisition in support of distance learning
- Facility improvements to enhance the health and safety standards of the school
- Facility expansion to support additional enrollment and allow for better spacing of classes
- Salary, stipend costs related to health and safety personnel
