Principal Report

Update on re-entry

Basic Facts

No projected date for high school hybrid re-entry

APS (all grade levels) still in remote through end of semester

Governor and PED: phase-in of younger grade levels and evaluate gating criteria. 16 days of elementary so far

Recent Updates/Requirements

- See COVID Toolkit

(ventilation/filtration updates, surveillance testing of staff)

- See NMPSIA memo

- Hybrid ratio guidance: half of teacher rosters, not of total enrollment

- Students on IEP's are allowed in-person currently, if coordinator and families work out a procedure

EMHS and most districts are strongly advocating for other small groups of struggling, disadvantaged students to be in-person

Hybrid Model Staff Feedback

Faculty survey results, for hybrid model as described:

23% are comfortable teaching in that model.

1 in 3 would apply for in-person teaching exemption.

Over 65% do not trust that all students and staff will abide by safety measures.

EMHS Re-entry commitments

East Mountain High School will continue to...

- Follow all NMPED and NMDOH regulations.
- Follow APS policies and procedures.
- When provided autonomy from the APS district, EMHS will develop procedures based on the safety of staff and families, with the oversight of school administration and Governing Council

Re-Entry Priorities

- 1-make sure campus follows all DOH/PED guidelines related to PPE, social distancing, masks, student ratios, and ventilation/filtration
- 2-implement procedures that emphasize the safety of the staff and faculty, as well as the students and greater EMHS community
- 3-in addition to students with IEP's currently allowed for in person experiences, EMHS will prioritize in person experiences for students most at risk of failure in classes for in person experiences
- 4- EMHS will participate in athletics, as outlined by the NMAA
- 5- EMHS will administer in person standardized testing in small pods
- 6- EMHS will consider in person community building and extra curricular opportunities as PED and DOH guidelines allow
- 7- remote learning will continue to be the norm for classes until full in person learning can resume
- 8- all plans will be flexible and subject to adjustment based on the scientific recommendations of the time

Re-Entry Conclusions

- No real decisions to be made yet (unless EMHS goes beyond PED guidelines).
- In the meantime:
 - Will advocate to get students in danger of failing to in-person experiences as soon as possible
 - Will work on all requirements to make the school eligible for in-person experiences
 - Will get quotes/feedback on stockpile of PPE, cleaning products, and ventilation/filtration, implement surveillance testing procedures
